Hyppolites: 2nd Century account of John the apostle being boiled in oil

Ireneus; Clement, Eusebius claim that John returned to Ephesus and died there.

How Various Theologians Read and Interpret Revelation

Preterist

Historic

Idealistic

Futurist - (**Prophetic**)

Jesus in Revelation calls this book A Prophecy

1800 OT references to future rule of Messiah on Earth

216 NT references to Christ's 318 references to his return or (second coming)

SEVEN CHURCHES:

1Ephesus 70-170 A.D. Smyrna 170-312 A.D.; Pergamum 312-606 A.D.; Thyratira 606-1517 A.D.;

Sardis 1517-1792 A.D.; Philadelphia 1792 to Rapture Open door missionary outreach: Laodicea, about

1900 to end of church era; the Liberal and unbelieving church. Overlaps the Philadelphia but is a church of the 'Tares'

Study of things of the last days: Eschatology Olivet Discourse, Matt.24; Luke 21; Mark 13.

Jesus prophetically summaries the destiny of Israel and Jerusalem for 4 of his disciples.
To information is a description of the destiny of Israel not the church as the church was as yet unrevealed and a mystery:

Daniel is referenced as the prophet to whom Gabriel detailed in detail the future of the world.
Through the 70 weeks prophecy.

Daniel 24 “ Seventy weeks[a] are determined

For your people and for your holy city,
To finish the transgression,
To make an end of[b] sins,
To make reconciliation for iniquity,
To bring in everlasting righteousness,
To seal up vision and prophecy,
And to anoint the Most Holy.

25 “ Know therefore and understand,
That from the going forth of the command
To restore and build Jerusalem
Until Messiah the Prince,
There shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks;
The street[c] shall be built again, and the wall,[d]
Even in troublesome times.

26 “ And after the sixty-two weeks
Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself;
And the people of the prince who is to come
Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary.
The end of it *shall be* with a flood,
And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week;
But in the middle of the week
He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering.
And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate,
Even until the consummation, which is determined,
Is poured out on the desolate.”

Eschatology must examine all of Scripture, The Law, The Prophets and the Psalms

Jesus declared he must fulfill all things written of him in the Law, The Prophets and the Psalms.

The Law – establishes festivals and rehearsals which are types of matters to be fulfilled

Amillennial - - Christ will not literally reign on a worldly throne

(Most who hold that Revelations is symbolic tend to hold this view)

Most of the classical and traditional denominations are Amillennial

The destiny of Israel having a prophetic destiny

Pre Millennialism - -The Messiah Christ will literally return to set up his rule on the earth upon the throne of David.

Ecclessiology

What is this entity called The Church?

When did it begin? Will it terminate? When?

Time of the Gentiles, Fulness of the Gentiles.

Will the church be raptured? The Harpazo

(Tons of literature addresses and debates this. Be careful.)

Contention exists between interpretations of this. Pre Tribulation Mid Tribulation Post Tribulation.

I believe that the evidence in Scripture when examined thoroughly will favor the pre tribulation view; The church is not appointed to wrath; The promises to the churches of escaping these days.

What follows the time of God's favor, the acceptable year of the Lord? (See Isa. 61, 1&2)

The Day of the Lord:

The prophets are repeat with pronouncements about this time of judgment and destruction.

Sample descriptions are found in:

7 Fold Patterns are found throughout Revelation

Seals, Trumpets, Bowls of Wrath

4 Things to be corrected that are out of place in this present age; these are put in their correct place by the end of the Revelation prophecy.

Church on earth; Resurrected and glorified in heaven

The Lamb is on His Father's throne shall be on his own throne upon the earth

Israel is returned only in part to its own land; Then will be, rescued, redeemed and restored.

Satan is not bound and moves about freely but will be bound
